ORDINANCE NO. 2015-O-01

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 2 “POLICE DEPARTMENT”
OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOW SPRINGS, COOK
COUNTY, ILLINOIS ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF THE DIRECTOR OF
PUBLIC SAFETY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Willow Springs, Cook County, Illinois (the *Village*) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Willow Springs (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) may amend the text of the Village code from time to time to meet the changing needs of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined it is necessary to establish the position of Director of Public Safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Willow Springs, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. Chapter 2 (“*Police Department*”) of Title 2 (“*Departments*”) is hereby amended by adding the following new Article to read as follows:

ARTICLE D. DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY

2-2D-1: ESTABLISHMENT OF POSITION; HIRING; TERM:

A. The village president is hereby authorized to appoint a Director of Public Safety, subject to the advice and consent of the board of trustees. The Director of Public Safety shall be a sworn officer and the qualifications for the position shall be determined by the president with approval

by the board of trustees. The term of the Director of Public Safety shall be for one year, commencing May 1, or the day of appointment if it shall occur thereafter and shall terminate on April 30 of the following year. The Director of Public Safety may be fired by the president prior to the completion of his term with the approval of the board of trustees. In the event of resignation or the termination of such term by lapse of time, the Director of Public Safety shall continue to carry out his duties until a successor has been appointed.

2-2D-2: DUTIES:

The Director of Public Safety is under the direction and control of the Village Administrator. The Director of Public Safety shall work in conjunction with the Police Chief and Fire District Chief regarding the budgets for the department, fire protection and public works. The Director of Public Safety shall have the following powers and duties: perform advisory tasks and exercise administrative responsibilities for the department and public works, serve as a liaison with the Fire District, oversee policy issues, seek and obtain grant funds to improve all aspects of public safety in the village, oversee, instruct or train members of the department and employees of public works to improve knowledge and efficiency and

2-2D-3: COMPENSATION:

The Director of Public Safety shall receive such compensation as established by the president and board of trustees shall from time to time determine.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


