ORDINANCE NO 2010-O-11

**AN ORDINANCE ABATING THE REAL ESTATE TAX HERETOFORE
LEVIED FOR THE TAX LEVY YEAR 2009 TO PAY THE DEBT SERVICE
ON \$2,585,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS (ALTERNATE
REVENUE SOURCE), SERIES 2004B, OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOW
SPRINGS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees (the "Corporate Authorities") of the Village of Willow Springs Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") by Ordinance adopted on the 9th day of December, 2004, being Ordinance No. 29-O-2004 (the "Bond Ordinance"), did provide for the issuance of \$2,700,000 General Obligation Bonds (Alternate Revenue Source), Series 2004B (the "Bonds") and the levy of a direct annual tax sufficient to pay the debt service on the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Village has Pledged Revenues (as defined in the Bond Ordinance) in the "Special Tax Allocation Fund - Accounts" referred to in Section 12 of the Bond Ordinance for the purpose of paying the debt service on the Bonds up to and including, December 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village that the tax heretofore levied in the Bond Ordinance for the tax levy year 2009 to pay the debt service on the Bonds be abated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Willow Springs, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: The above stated preamble paragraphs are incorporated as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: Abatement of Real Estate Tax. The real estate tax heretofore levied for the year 2009 in the Bond Ordinance is hereby abated in its entirety.

SECTION 3: Filing of Ordinance. Forthwith upon the adoption of this Ordinance No. 2010-O-11, the Village Attorney shall file a certified copy hereof with the County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, and it shall be the duty of said County Clerk to abate said real estate tax levied under the Bond Ordinance for the tax levy year 2009, in accordance with the provisions hereof.




