ORDINANCE # 2010-O-16

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PREVAILING WAGE STANDARDS IN THE
VILLAGE OF WILLOW SPRINGS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS 60480**

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois (the "State") has enacted the "Prevailing Wage Act," 820ILCS 130/1 *et seq.* (the "Act") which is an act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State that a wage of no less than the general prevailing hourly rate as paid for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed, shall be paid to all laborers, mechanics and other workers employed by or on behalf of any and all public bodies engaged in public works; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the Village of Willow Springs investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in the Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said Village of Willow Springs employed in performing construction of public works, for said Village of Willow Springs; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Willow Springs have ascertained and examined the prevailing wage classifications and rates determined by the Department of labor for Cook County for June 2009.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Willow Springs, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals and legislative finding are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2: To the extent and as required by the Act, the general prevailing rates of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in

construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village of Willow Springs is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rates of wages for construction work in the Cook County area, as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June of the current year (See Exhibit "A").

SECTION 3: As required by the Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rates of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's June prevailing rates for construction work undertaken by the Village of Willow Springs. The definition of any terms appearing in the Ordinance which are also used in the Act shall be the same as in the Act.

SECTION 4: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction undertaken of the Village of Willow Springs to the extent required by the Act.

SECTION 5: The Village Clerk shall publicly post this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wages and keep it available for inspection at the Village Hall by any interested party. A copy of the determination or of the currently revised determination of the prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specification.

SECTION 6: The Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses and have requested copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 7: The Village Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Honorable Jesse White, Secretary of State of Illinois, Index Department 41 East Monroe Street, Springfield, IL. 62756 and with the Illinois Department of Labor, Prevailing Wage Division, One West Old State Capitol Plaza, Room 300, Springfield, IL. 62701.

SECTION 8: Within thirty (30) days after the filing with the Secretary of State, the Village Clerk shall causes a notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Village stating:


SECTION 10: All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
