ORDINANCE NO. 2011-O-14

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2 “DEPARTMENTS”,
CHAPTER 2 “POLICE DEPARTMENT” OF THE VILLAGE
CODE OF THE OF WILLOW SPRINGS, COOK COUNTY,
ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Willow Springs (the “*Village*”) is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-21, requires that municipalities employing part-time police officers shall establish hiring standards for said officers and shall submit those standards to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Willow Springs (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) may from time to time amend the text of Village Code when it is determined to be in the best interests of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined it necessary to establish part-time police officer hiring standards for the Village in order to maintain compliance with Illinois State Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Willow Springs, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set

forth in their entirety.

Section 2: Chapter 2 (*"Police Department"*) of Title 2 (*"Departments"*) of the Village Code of the Village of Willow Springs is hereby amended by adding the following new Article to read, as follows:

ARTICLE B:

2-2B-1: Employment; compensation.

The Village may employ part-time police officers in such numbers as the Board of Trustees shall from time to time deem necessary. Prior to employment, part-time police officers shall be subject to a background check, including without limitation, a fingerprint verification by the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Illinois State Police Bureau of Identification. Part-time police officers shall receive such compensation as authorized by the Board of Trustees.

2-2B-2: Discipline.

Part-time police officers shall be under the jurisdiction of the Chief of Police and may be discharged or disciplined at any time without notice, without hearing, and without cause. Part-time police officers serve at the discretion of the Board of Trustees, do not have any property rights in employment, and may be removed by the Board of Trustees at any time. Part-time police officers shall comply with all applicable rules issued for the Police Department.

2-2B-3: Hiring standards.

Any person employed as a part-time police officer must meet the following standards:

- (a) Be of good moral character, of temperate habits, of sound health, and physically and mentally able to perform assigned duties.
- (b) Be at least 21 years of age.
- (c) Pass a medical examination.
- (d) Possess a high school diploma or GED certificate.
- (e) Possess a valid State of Illinois driver's license.

(f) Be a citizen of the United States.

(g) Receive training and be certified as required under the Intergovernmental Law Enforcement Officer's In-Service Training Act in accordance with the procedures for part-time police officers established by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board.

(h) Not be convicted of any felony or misdemeanor, except those allowed under 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-6.

2-2B-4: Powers and duties.

Part-time police officers shall be assigned to perform duties by the Chief of Police. Every Part-time police officer shall obey the orders and directions of his or her supervisor. Part-time police officers may not supervise or direct full-time police officers and shall not be used as permanent replacements for permanent full-time police officers.

Section 3: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4: All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
