AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 4 "BUSINESS REGULATIONS", CHAPTER 1 "GENERAL BUSINESS LICENSE REGULATIONS" OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE OF WILLOW SPRINGS, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS (FEES)

WHEREAS, the Village of Willow Springs (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented and amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Willow Springs (the "*Corporate Authorities*") may from time to time amend the text of Village Code when it is determined to be in the best interests of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined it necessary to amend the business license fee regulations of the Village in order to more effectively be able to provide services to businesses and citizens in the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Willow Springs, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2: Schedule A ("*General Business Manufacturing*") of Section 4-1-14 ("*Enumeration of Licenses; Fees*") of Chapter 1 ("*General Business License Regulations*") of Title 4 ("*Business Regulations*") of the Village Code of the Village of

Willow Springs is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and adding the following new underlined language to read, as follows:

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


