ORDINANCE NO. 2014-O-05

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VILLAGE OF WILLOW SPRINGS FOR FAU ROUTE 3565, ROUTE 171 AT 104TH
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WHEREAS, the Village of Willow Springs (the "*Village*") is a duly organized and existing municipal corporation created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as from time to time supplemented.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Willow Springs, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The Agreement by and between the Illinois Department of Transportation and the Village of Willow Springs, Cook County, Illinois to widen, resurface and install traffic signals for FAU Route 3565, Route 171, at 104th Ave/Willow Springs Road (the "*Agreement*"), a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A, is hereby approved in substantially the form presented to the Village Board, with such necessary changes as may be authorized by the Village President, the execution thereof to constitute the approval by the Village of any and all changes or revisions therein contained.

Section 3: The officials, officers, and employees of the Village are hereby authorized to take such further actions as are necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Ordinance and the Agreement.

Section 4: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.


Section 5: All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


