

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-O-24

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING PREVAILING WAGE RATES TO BE PAID TO LABORERS, MECHANICS AND OTHER WORKERS PERFORMING CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE VILLAGE OF WILLOW SPRINGS

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted “An Act Regulating Wages of Laborers, Mechanics, and Other Workers Employed in Any Public Works by the State, County, City of Any Public Body or Any Political Subdivision or by Any One Under Contract for Public Works”, approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Village Board of the Village of Willow Springs investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics, and other workers in the locality of said Willow Springs, employed in performing construction of public works for said Village of Willow Springs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOW SPRINGS, ILLINOIS:

SECTION ONE: To the extent and as required by “An Act Regulating Wages of Laborers, Mechanics, and Other Workers Employed in Any Public Works by State, County, City of Any Public Body or Any Political Subdivision or by Any One Under Contract for Public Works”, approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics, and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Village of Willow Springs, is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Cook County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June 2017, that incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms in this Ordinance, which are also used in the aforesaid Act, shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION TWO: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply to said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Village of Willow Springs to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION THREE: The Village Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Village of Willow Springs this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

SECTION FOUR: The Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer and to any association of employers, who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION FIVE: The Village Clerk shall properly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION SIX: The Village Clerk shall publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION SEVEN: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.
