**ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOW SPRINGS  
AMENDING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 1, SECTION 5 OF THE WILLOW SPRINGS  
VILLAGE CODE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOW SPRINGS, ILLINOIS:**

**SECTION 1:** The following changes are hereby made to Section 4-1-5 of the Willow Springs Municipal Code (additions underlined and deletions noted with ~~striketrough~~ text):

**4-1-5: LICENSE PROCEDURES; RENEWALS:**

- A. All licensable commercial activities or establishments as described in Section 4-1-14 of this Chapter, shall file with the Village Clerk an application for a license to operate the commercial activity in the Village no later than ~~November 15~~ December 31 prior to each subsequent license year or not less than thirty (30) days before the applicant desires to commence operation in the Village. If any person fails to file its renewal application by ~~November 15~~ December 31 of each year, an additional fee of ~~ten dollars~~ fifty (~~\$10.00~~ 50.00) shall be charged for ~~each day after November 15 until the date of said renewal application is received in the office of the Village Clerk.~~ Delinquency may also result in suspension and/or revocation of the right to conduct commercial activities within the Village.
- B. All initial licenses authorized to be issued and required to be procured shall be issued by the President and Board of Trustees.
- C. The required fee for each license issued shall be collected in full at the time ~~the application for a license, or the renewal thereof~~ of issuance, is filed with by the office of the Village Clerk. In no event shall any rebate or refund be made of any license fee, or part thereof, by reason of the death of the licensee or by any reason of nonuse of the license or discontinuance of the operation of the commercial establishment.
- ~~D. In the first year that this Chapter is in effect, the requirement that all applications be received no later than November 15 shall be waived. However, any application received after January 1 shall be charged an additional fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each day until the date of said renewal application is received in the office of the Village Clerk.~~

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance shall not be held to repeal a former ordinance as to any offense committed against the former ordinance or as to any act done, any penalty, forfeiture or punishment so incurred, or any right accrued or claim arising under the former ordinance, or in any way whatsoever affect any such offense or act so committed or so done, or any penalty, forfeiture or punishment so incurred to any right accrued to claims arising before this Ordinance takes effect, save only that the proceedings thereafter shall conform to the ordinance in force at the time of such proceedings, as far as practicable.

**SECTION 3:** That if any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. The Village Board declare hereby that they would have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance, if they had known that such part or parts thereof would be declared unconstitutional.

**SECTION 4:** The Village Clerk of the Village of Willow Springs is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

**SECTION 5:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form.

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




