AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 5B OF THE WILLOW
SPRINGS VILLAGE CODE IN RELATION TO THE DUTIES OF THE
PRESIDENT PRO TEM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOW SPRINGS,
ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: The following changes are hereby made to Section 1-5B-3 of the Willow Springs Municipal Code (additions underlined and deletions noted with ~~strike through~~ text):

1-5B-3: PRESIDENT PRO TEM:

- A. Election. The Village Board shall elect one of its members to act as President Pro Tem.
- B. Duties.
 - 1. The President Pro Tem shall perform all of the duties of the President during an absence or disability of the President. Absence of the President shall occur whenever the exercise of Presidential duties and/or powers requires the physical presence of the President and the President is not able to be physically present: i) at a previously scheduled event or ii) within an hour following notice given by the Village Administrator or Village Clerk.
 - 2. In the event the President fails to attend a meeting of the Village Board or a portion thereof, the President Pro Tem shall chair the meeting; and while so serving as chairman, shall have the right to vote only in the capacity as a board member. In the absence of both the President and President Pro Tem from a meeting of the Village Board, the Village Board shall elect one of its members to act as a temporary chairman.
 - 3. The President Pro Tem shall serve as the deputy liquor control commissioner and shall exercise all powers and duties of the

liquor control commissioner in the absence of or at the request of the President.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall not be held to repeal a former ordinance as to any offense committed against the former ordinance or as to any act done, any penalty, forfeiture or punishment so incurred, or any right accrued or claim arising under the former ordinance, or in any way whatsoever affect any such offense or act so committed or so done, or any penalty, forfeiture or punishment so incurred to any right accrued to claims arising before this Ordinance takes effect, save only that the proceedings thereafter shall conform to the ordinance in force at the time of such proceedings, as far as practicable.

SECTION 3: That if any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this Ordinance. The Village Board declare hereby that they would have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance, if they had known that such part or parts thereof would be declared unconstitutional.


SECTION 4: The Village Clerk of the Village of Willow Springs is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.




