ORDINANCE 2018-O-49

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 2D OF THE WILLOW SPRINGS VILLAGE CODE REGARDING RAFFLE LICENSES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOW SPRINGS, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The following changes are made to title 10, Chapter 6, Section 2 D of the Willow Springs Municipal Code (additions underlined and deletions noted with ~~strike through~~)

10-6-2: LICENSING:

[...]

D. Maximum Value Of Prizes:

1. The aggregate retail value of all prizes or merchandise awarded by a licensee in a single raffle shall not exceed ~~one hundred thousand~~ five million dollars (~~\$100,000.00~~ 5,000,000.00).

2. The retail value of each individual prize awarded by a licensee in a single raffle shall not exceed ~~fifty thousand~~ five million dollars (~~\$50,000.00~~ 5,000,000.00).

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall not be held to repeal a former ordinance as to any offense committed against the former ordinance or as to any act done, any penalty, forfeiture or punishment so incurred, or any right accrued or claim arising under the former ordinance, or in any way whatsoever affect any such offense or act so committed or so done, or any penalty, forfeiture or punishment so incurred to any right accrued to claims arising before this Ordinance takes effect, save only that the proceedings thereafter shall conform to the ordinance in force at the time of such proceedings, as far as practicable.

SECTION 3: That if any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts of this

Ordinance. The Village Board declare hereby that they would have passed the remaining parts of this Ordinance, if they had known that such part or parts thereof would be declared unconstitutional.

SECTION 4: The Village Clerk of the Village of Willow Springs is directed hereby to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form.
