Current Crime Trends

- Theft from Motor Vehicles are continuously occurring in our Village along with several neighboring communities. Most vehicle entries are taking place overnight in the early morning hours with a majority of the vehicles ***being unlocked*** with their garage door remote controls being left inside. Most vehicles are parked in residential driveways and the offender(s) are then gaining access into residential garages and taking vehicles (with car keys left inside) or personal property through unlocked vehicles that are also parked in the garage.

Stolen Motor Vehicle


- 8100 block Rosemere Ct: 2008 Black Mercedes Benz 2 door.

Safety Tips:

- Remove all valuables from your vehicles especially, purses, guns, wallets, keys, remote controls, when you park your cars.
- Make sure you double-check that all car doors are locked, including all vehicles parked in your driveway and garage.
- Secure valuable items in the trunk if leaving the parked and unattended.
- Use motion sensor lighting
- Surveillance/video cameras
- Immediately call 911 if you observe someone checking locks on parked cars or breaking into or entering yours or a neighbor's vehicle.
